We want Premier League Kicks to be an amazing, rewarding, and enjoyable experience for EVERYONE. To make this happen, we have created a participant and a staff Code of Conduct, which we ask you to agree to follow. Every participant will be expected to read and agree to the code of conduct.

General

- Be respectful!
- Listen to and value what your coach and other staff say to you, respect their decisions and instructions.
- Always speak to others with respect and listen to people's opinions, even if they are different from your own.
- Respect your venue and facilities we are using.
- Be open to working with people you don't know and recognise that everyone has something to offer, and our differences are a good thing!

The following will not be tolerated on Premier League Kicks:

- The use of DRUGS & ALCOHOL before and during sessions on kicks sites will not be tolerated. Anyone suspected of doing so will be asked to leave immediately and the relevant authorities will be informed.
- Bullying of any kind
- Physical Abuse – pushing, hitting, pinching etc.
- Verbal Abuse – name-calling, spreading rumours, teasing etc.
- Emotional – ridiculing, humiliating, ignoring etc.
- Racial Abuse – taunts, graffiti, gestures
- Sexual – unwanted physical contact or abuse
- Weapons, or anything that could be perceived as a weapon
